We had sugar skulls, paper carnations and ofrenda making workshops, an altar art walk and contest, then a celebration in Spainhower park – complete with Mariachi band and flamenco dancing. It was well attended by the Hispanic community.
- Former president for the Owens Valley Growers Coop. LA DWP took all the water rights in the Owens Valley leaving dry lake. Our best defense was to thrive, thus we promoted food sovereignty,
- When in Sausalito, I founded the project <https://www.charlesvandammeferry.org/> Via events, exhibitions and a documentary film, we told the story of a local ferryboat built in 1916, successfully creating awareness and raising funds. We have since saved the ferryboats artifacts from demolition and are currently restoring it for public display in Waldo Point State Park, Sausalito, Marin, Ca.
- In Big Sur I was a docent at the Monterey Bay Aquarium as a guide, specializing in climate change. I also founded and Soul River Studios, Community art space.

THE REST

Story telling, scuba diving, travel, designing kaleidoscopes, horse riding, film, karaoke, fire dancing, playing banjo, marine biology, bio mimicry, throwing large costume parties, recycling junk into art, creative problem solving, inventing, and a whole lot of laughing.
